**Criteria for applying to the
“NDCCPI Pennies for Providers” Fund**

The “Pennies for Providers” fund is monies donated by the child care providers, child care associations and concerned people in an effort to provide a small stipend to ND licensed child care providers who have suffered significant loss of child care items due to natural causes such as fire, flood, or tornado.

This fund is collected thru and administered by “North Dakota Child Care Providers, Inc.”

The following is the criteria for applying to the NDCCPI “Pennies for Providers” fund:

1. The applicant must be a currently licensed childcare provider residing and doing child care in the state of North Dakota. Applicants are not required to be a member of NDCCPI. Loss of child care items must have occurred no longer than 9 months prior to submitting application.
2. The applicant must provide a general description of his/her circumstances which prompted the request, and of the child care items damaged or destroyed.
3. The applicant must complete the application form and return it to NDCCPI.
4. NDCCPI has the right to approve or deny any application.
5. If approved, the amount of assistance will be determined by the NDCCPI Board and will be mailed along with a copy of the application to the applicant in a timely fashion.
6. The amount of the stipend will not be less than \$25.00 or more than \$100.00 as monies are available, per approved applicant.
7. At any time that the “Pennies for Providers” fund becomes exhausted of its resources, this application process will be null and void.
